GUIDANCE AND CRITERIA

In choosing the recipients of the Australia Day Awards, consideration is given to the nominee's achievements in the year immediately prior to receiving the award, as well as their past achievements and ongoing contribution to the community. An individual need only be nominated once to be considered.

Selection criteria for Citizen of the Year, Senior Citizen of the Year and Young Citizen of the Year include:

- Significant contribution to the City of Whyalla
- An inspirational role model for both the Whyalla and Australian communities
- The scope of impact the individual's contribution has on Whyalla
- Whether the nominee has had to overcome any particular difficulties or hurdles

Selection criteria for Community Service awards include:

- Voluntary commitment to the Whyalla community and/or sporting club/s
- An inspirational role model for the Whyalla community and/or sporting club/s
- The scope of impact the individual's contribution has on Whyalla and/or sporting club/s

The selection panel will also give consideration to the following in assessing and comparing nominations against the above criteria:

- Personal, academic and professional achievements
- Contribution in the relevant field (how has the nominee or event 'put back' into their field to benefit others)
- Demonstrated leadership, innovation and creativity
- Contribution to development of regional community and/or economy
- Future goals and likely impact
- Degree of difficulty of the achievement and sacrifices made
- Previous awards and recognition
- Voluntary work beyond paid employment
- Nature and length of activity or service
- Achievements as an individual or as part of a group or organisation
